Hopefully, by now you have heard of Operation Inasmuch and are already thinking about which project(s) you want to participate in.

Just in case you haven't heard, on Saturday, May 2, Lutherans statewide will participate in a community service blitz day called Operation Inasmuch. This day is intended to encourage Lutherans of all ages to engage in service to others in the community. Our Saviour is joining with Faith, Mt. Tabor, and Transfiguration Lutheran churches to complete projects in the West Columbia/Cayce area. These projects will be funded in part by Thrivent, corporate grants, and contributions from each church body.

Our Saviour will be the collection site for box fans, our parking lot will be used for a car wash, and our kitchen will be used to prepare lunches to be delivered to workers at their sites. Church council has committed \$400 of the proceeds from our yard sale to the overall project.
