We will begin the day with a kickoff service at Transfiguration Lutheran at 8:30 am. All teams will meet immediately after the kickoff service in designated spots throughout the sanctuary to get final instructions.

**Childcare** (*Each Church / Leader from each congregation / 9-4*) - Care for preschool children (infant thru grade K) of adult volunteers to facilitate parents' involvement in Operation Inasmuch

**Car Wash** (*Our Saviour / Pastor Paul Aebischer / 9:30-2*) - Provide a free car wash with donations accepted for Operation Inasmuch Ministries

**Children's Choir Project** (*TLC / Frank Griffin / 9-2*) – Sing at area nursing homes and visit with residents. Provide baked goods for nursing staff to show appreciation - *Children, grades 1-5*

**Children's Choir—Adult Partners** (*TLC / Frank Griffin / 9-2*) – Provide adult supervision & transportation for children as they visit the nursing homes

**Dang-it-Dolls** (*Cayce Masonic Lodge / Dianne Fulmer / 9-3*) - Assemble Dang-it-Dolls for Deployed Military. These are stuffed, stress relief dolls that are distributed to our men and women as they are deployed for duty. Something for people at all skill levels (cutting, sewing, stuffing, gluing, decorating, etc.) (40–50 volunteers)

**Fire Station & Police Station Visits** (*Each Church / Need Leaders / 9-1*) - Teams will bake and deliver warm cookies to Fire Stations & Police Stations to say “*Thank You.*” This is a great opportunity for adults and children to work together – *All Ages*
