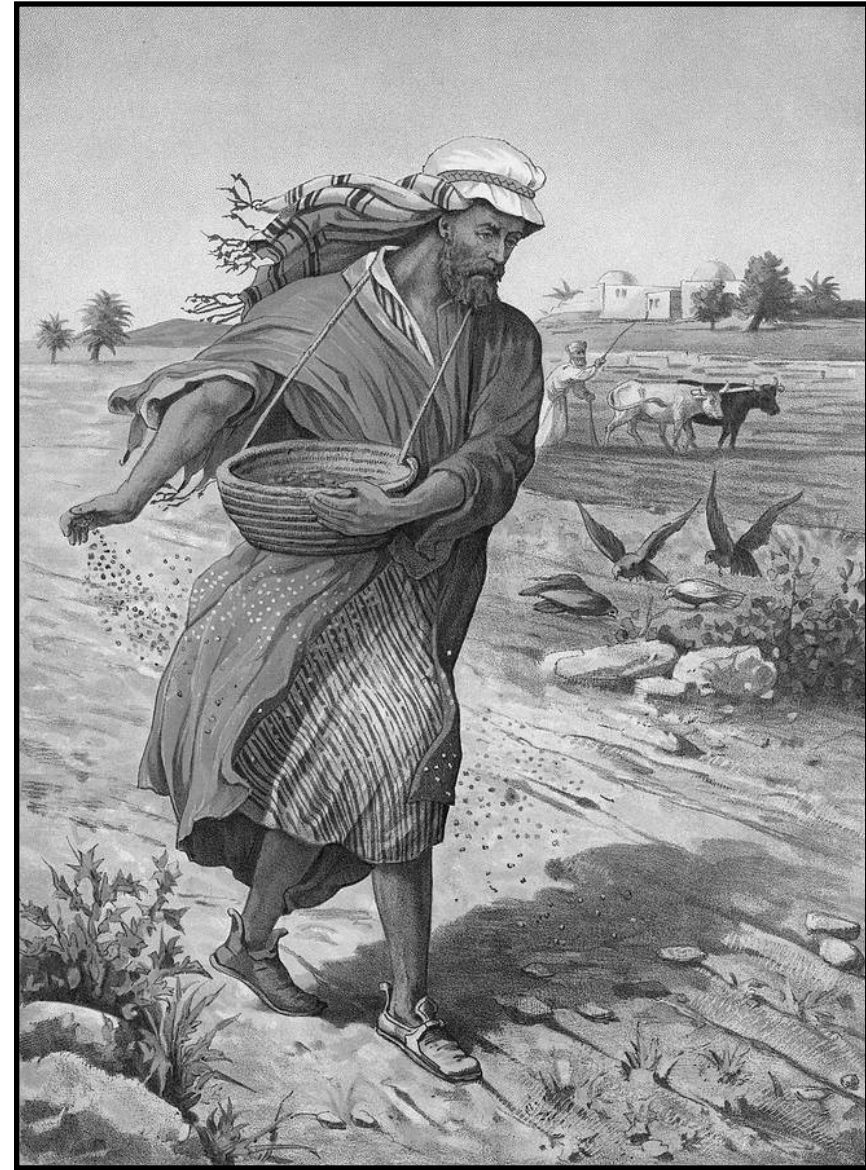
A New Road 35
